FORAGE PEAS JUPITER

OVERVIEW

JUPITER is a large blue pea. It was bred in the United kingdom and after extensive trialling it has shown very good adaptability to South African conditions. JUPITER produces a large, smooth skinned pea with green cotyledon colour.

HISTORY

After commercial evaluation the responses from end-users proved very encouraging. JUPITER proved itself useful for canning and for split peas. JUPITER was found to split readily and excellent recovery rates are achieved.

USES

- Canning Whole seed
- Splitting Pre-packing market
- Animal feed Whole milled pea in ration
- As a forage pea and as a green manure crop due to its bulk and dry matter production
- Being a legume it fixes nitrogen if correctly inoculated
- Can be used in mixtures with cereals
- Does not withstand grazing and best used in a cereal mixture for silage
