IN THE SEED INDUSTRY

The personnel of Capstone Seeds S.A. have been involved in the Seed and Agricultural Industry for more than twenty five years. Capstone has experienced staff who manage production, research and marketing of seed and have established a network within South Africa and beyond its borders.

The sales and administrative offices in Howick, of Capstone Seeds S.A., are strategically situated 120kms from Durban. Howick is a small town in the KwaZulu-Natal Midlands that is adjacent to the N3, a major arterial route to Johannesburg and the interior. Capstone Seeds' main warehouse and factory, in Harrismith, is on the same route, which is conveniently located for our producers and growers alike. In addition we have a Research and Development office based at our Head Office in Howick, as well as a depot down in the Cape at Humansdorp outside Port Elizabeth.

Capstone Seeds S.A. handles an extensive range of seed from pasture and forage seed to hybrid maize and sunflower seed - these seeds are adapted to a wide range of conditions. Capstone also handles varieties that have been bred by Agricultural Research Council (ARC), Nelson Genetics' Dr Sydney Nelson, and others. The Company processes a wide range of seed for agricultural purposes, sourced from registered growers countrywide. Seed, produced in Africa, North and South America, Australia and New Zealand, is imported and exported to over 30 countries worldwide.

Each consignment of seed received at our factory is processed and tested internally in our in-house laboratory, as well as externally to ensure the seed complies with the buyer / importing countries requirements. The seed is then packaged and distributed.

CAP 122-60

This is a highly prolific variety with long cylindrical cobs. This variety can be grown at a population of 80 000 plants per hectare under optimum conditions. It responds well to fertilizer and irrigation, tolerant to Helminthosporium blight, tolerant to Stalk rot, susceptible to Grey leaf spot and Rust. It has a yield potential of up to 15 MT/ha. Days to maturity 125-135.

Westerwold Ryegrass (*Lolium multiflorum*)

Is an annual type that is very fast growing and quick to establish. Unlike Italian ryegrass, it forms stems during the sowing year. Westerwold produces high levels of hay or silage when cut within three to six months of sowing. Differences between diploid and tetraploid varieties are small.

Festulolium

Is a cross between Festuca (meadow fescue/ tall fescue) and Lolium (Italian ryegrass/ perennial ryegrass). Festulolium combines high quality with good winter hardiness, persistence and stress tolerance. As a result of a strategic partnership with DLF, Capstone has a range of types similar to tall fescue and ryegrass, all with improved characteristics derived from the parent crossings. These varieties provide for extended growth of high-quality grass in cold regions
