

KALE PROTEOR

OVERVIEW

A leafy kale of intermediate stem height, with high yield potential, PROTEOR is a palatable variety with a thin stem and a high leaf to stem ratio (very often more than 50% leaf), ensuring high utilization. It also has good winter hardiness and good tolerance of aphids, club root and other diseases.

SUITABILITY

PROTEOR may be used as a high quality and well proven feed for sheep, cattle and deer during late summer, early autumn or even during winter. Light grazing's in summer; autumn will result in some re-growth. Break-fencing is recommended for optimum feed utilization of kale crops.
